
Your Schapendoes Twinflowers McMeya Roseto Rimfire was assessed on 3-11-2018 in Växjö, Sverige by mrs.R. Lochs-Romans.

In this respect, the Dutch Breeding Committee (FAC) has assessed its suitability to contribute towards the advancement of the breed.

Result: SUITABLE

This assessment is a recommendation for breeding.
The breeding rules for each country must be followed.

A dog is qualified to breed (*according to Dutch rules*) if either:

- a. At a maximum of two inventories it is assessed to be "suitable to contribute to the advancement of the breed". These inventories have to be done by two different judges qualified for the breed and trained in the Netherlands. The dog must be at least 15 months old and there must be at least 6 months between the two inventories, unless the dog is older than 24 months.
- b. Or, if it has been assessed at an inventory to be "suitable to contribute to the advancement of the breed" and also has been awarded the qualification of Very Good or Excellent at least twice at a club match organized by the Schapendoes Club or at a CAC/CACIB show, whereby the qualifications must be awarded by different judges qualified for the breed and trained in the Netherlands. Furthermore, at least one of these show qualifications must have been awarded when the dog was 21 months or older.
- c. Or one inventory it is assessed to be "suitable to contribute to the advancement of the breed" if the dog is at least 24 months of age.
